Computer Use Policy

The Owen Sound & North Grey Union Public Library provides computer workstations with Internet access to ensure equal access to information and resources. While the Internet provides a variety of resources for people of different age levels and with varying points of view, the service provided by the Library is intended for educational, recreational and informational uses.

The following is prohibited:

- Use of workstations for illegal, actionable or criminal purposes or to access unauthorized areas.
- Receiving or displaying sexually suggestive, degrading or pornographic materials, or text and/or graphics which are illegal, unethical or offensive.
- o Infringement of copyright and other intellectual property rights.

Users are responsible for:

- Determining what material they wish to access and evaluating the accuracy, reliability and appropriateness of the information.
- o The consequences of giving out personal information over the Internet.
- o All commercial transactions they enter into via the Internet.
- o Respecting the privacy of others using the computers.
